PUBLICITY & AWARDS: The GS panels are here, really. John will have 20-25 polo shirts with our logo on them for give away's at awards.

WORK ASSIGNMENTS: Club's will need to provide an announcer and 2 starters for their assigned races. Do not circulate the current race schedule, there will be changes, see the website for the official schedule.

NEWSLETTER: Will be distributed by e-mail with hard copies available at the races.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Vet-A Women, only 13 registered, not enough for a vet class.
- D2-Men, only 3 registered, wait until after qualifier.
- Meeting location – continue at Merrill Lynch.

NEW BUSINESS:

- A motion was made and passed to waive work assignments for racers over 70 years old.
- Mike proposed a major rewrite of our rules to make them more current and smaller.
