INSTRUCTIONAL CLINIC: Discussed adding a Race Clinic to the program and promote to our racers.

REGISTRATION: 279 Registrations in hand. Registration will be in the cafeteria.

FINANCIAL: \$13,400 cash on hand.

PUBLICITY & AWARDS: John suggested that we purchase three banners, one to be placed at the Boyne River Brewery, one for the base of the race hill the other TBD. The purchase will be delayed until we determine the cost of the banners and the potential need to replace one of our timers.

COURSE OPERATIONS: The assignment sheet for Coc, Course Maintenance and Pace Setters will be posted on the web and in the warming house. There was a great deal of discussion regarding course maintenance, the CoC is responsible to determine the need for slipping and maintenance. If the racers have a concern with the condition of the course they should get with the CoC.
