PUBLICITY & RECRUITMENT: Debbie has been working on getting or program information to the beer leagues, they are run through the ski schools, she will keep working on. Banners – approved the purchase of 2 small banners (2' x 6', \$100 ea.) and 1 large banner (3' x 10', 200 ea.).
