SPONSORSHIP / AWARDS: The weekend individual awards have been delivered up North. Awards will be given out Saturday in the Civic Center Basement. John is in conversation with The Ski Company of Rochester regarding sponsorship.

EQUIPMENT: Mike will contact Boyne to insure that the on hill wiring is working. The new timer has been delivered.
