Course Setting – Jason Kanakry: No issues. Jason suggested moving the start times up, because one of the courses was ready an hour before the start. Scott did not want to make any changes to the start times and interject more confusion. Timing changes would be considered for next year. Gary Konsa suggested moving the finish line as far out from the timing shack as possible. This would allow setting the slalom course closer to the snow guns where the snow is deeper. Mick said they are limited by the length of wire.

Computers & Results: - Steve Coatney: There was a complaint raised by GaryBloodworth on the upgrades from Searchmont. He did not feel they were handled right and thought the course factor that was used was not correct. He also thought we had an excessive amount of upgrades that came out of Searchmont. Mike Sayers the keeper of the course factors was not present to respond. Since the results were from Searchmont and already accepted as final there was nothing that could be done. Scott suggested that some racers may want to finish the season in the class they are in rather than upgrade in the middle of the season. The discussion was dropped at this point to be addressed at a later meeting. Steve made motion to accept results Jason 2nd there were no objections results are final.

Course Operations – Ted Jablonski/Gary Bloodworth: Everything looking good. There were some complaints that a couple of gates at the last race could have used more maintenance. Some of the gates did deteriorate worse than normal, but because of the snow conditions and weather there was not much more that could have been done. Ted emphasizes to the COC error on the side of safety when making a decision to slip or not.
