## RACING REMINDERS:

**Please review these general reminders in preparation for our first race weekend of the 2026 Race Season.**

### **Work Assignments**

**All racers are required to complete at least one work assignment for each 2 day race weekend and two work assignments for each 3 day race weekend.** If you do not have a permanent or already assigned work assignment, please look out for the Gate Judge sign up email. Work assignment sign up will also be available at the Registration Table.

**Reminder: Pace Setting does not count as a work assignment.**

### **Proof of Work Assignment:**

Green Cards or Gate Judge Cards will be required for all racers as proof of work assignment completion. Green cards will be available at the Registration Table and Gate Judge Cards will be located in each Gate Judge Bib. Gate Judges do not need to submit a Green Card as their Gate Judge Card is evidence of their work assignment.

**Green Cards & Gate Judge Cards should be turned in immediately after the completion of the race. Gate Judge Cards should not be left in the Gate Judge Bibs. All cards should be filled out completely, with all required information, including your full name and bib number.**

### **Lift Tickets**

The Superbowl Lift has fixed RFID scanners, so having your lift ticket at all times is required, even when racing. No matter how nice you are the machine does not understand that you do have a lift ticket, but it is in your coat at the top of the hill.
